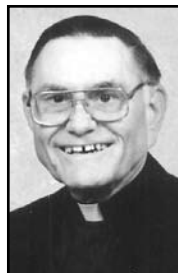

Father David Dougherty, CPPS



Father Dougherty was born Nov. 27, 1922 in Dodge City. He was incorporated into the Society of the Precious Blood on Dec. 8, 1944. He was ordained March 25, 1949, at Carthagen, Ohio, by the Most Rev. George Rehring, auxiliary bishop of Cincinnati. He celebrated his first Mass at Sacred Heart Church in Dodge City on March 28, 1949.

He served as assistant pastor at St. Edward's, Cleveland, Ohio (1949-58), and St. Mary, Garden City (1958-65), before receiving his first pastorate.

He was pastor at St. James, Maine, Minn., with a mission at Battle Lake (1965-70), and St. Mary's, Centerville, Iowa (1970-78).

Father Dougherty served as a member of the provincial formation committee at Liberty, Mo., (1978-81).

His remaining pastorates in Kansas were at St. Mary, Garden City (1981-85); St. Patrick, Great Bend (1984-85); St. Anthony of Padua, Leoti, with St. Joseph, Tribune (1985-89); St. Mary, Marienthal, with St. Anthony, Leoti (1989-93), followed by St. Patrick, Sedalia, Mo., (1993-95).

In 1995 he moved to the Precious Blood Center in Liberty, Mo., where he served as a member of the commission on membership.

In 2002 he moved to the St. Charles Center where he resided until his death on Aug. 15, 2006, at the age of 83.

Father Al Ebach, CPPS, vice-provincial of the Kansas City Province, was the celebrant of the Mass of the Resurrection at Assumption Chapel at the St. Charles Center in Carthagen. Burial was in the Community cemetery.
