Father Julian Voskuhl, CPPS



Father Voskuhl was born July 29, 1898, in St. Wendelin, Ohio. He entered the Society of the Precious Blood in 1915 to begin his studies for the priesthood at St. Mary's Preparatory Seminary, Burkettsville, Ohio. He was incorporated as a member of the Society on Dec. 3, 1922. He was ordained May 17, 1928, by the Most Rev. John McNicholas, OP, archbishop of Cincinnati, at St. Charles Seminary, Carthagena, Ohio.

His assignments during his nearly 50 years of priesthood included: associate editor of the Messenger of the Precious Blood, Carthagena, Ohio (1928-32); pastor at Our Lady of Guadalupe, Montezuma, Ohio (1932-33); chaplain at St. Agnes Convent, Fond du Lac, Wisc. (1933-39); chaplain at the Alexian Brothers novitiate, Signal Mountain, Tenn., (1939-40); assistant pastor at Our Lady of Good Counsel, Cleveland, Ohio (1940-47); chaplain at Holy Cross Hospital, Merrill, Wisc., (1955-57); chaplain at St. Rose Hospital, Great Bend, Kans.. (1957-60); chaplain at St. Joseph Home, Kenosha, Wisc., (1960-69); assistant pastor at St. Anthony, Park Falls, Wisc., (1969-71), and assistant pastor at St. Mary, Nebraska City, Neb., (1971-76).

Father Voskuhl retired to St. Charles Seminary in 1976. He died Jan. 26, 1978, a victim of the blizzard that struck the entire state of Ohio. The Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated in the Chapel of the Assumption at St. Charles Seminary. Burial was in the cemetery at Carthagena.
