

## Diocese of Dodge City Seminary Applicant Checklist

### Phase I (can be done in any order)

- Schedule formal visit with Fr. John Stang (vocationpromotion@dcdiocese.org)
  
- Complete the Candidate Application form
  - Complete Candidate Application (available by selecting “Thinking about the Priesthood” at [www.dcdiocese.org/vocations](http://www.dcdiocese.org/vocations))
  - Write your autobiography and two short essays
  
- Schedule lay committee interview through the Vocations Office (Fr. John Stang)
  
- Give Pastor Recommendation form to your pastor
  
- Give out two General Recommendation forms
  
- Request a newly-issued baptismal certificate from parish of baptism (That includes notation for First Communion and Confirmation)
  
- Request high school (if applying for college seminary) and college transcript
  
- Request ACT/SAT scores if applying for college seminary
  
- Attend a Protecting God’s Children Awareness session and consent to criminal background check

## Phase II

- Schedule 2<sup>nd</sup> formal visit with Fr. Stang
- Schedule family home visit through the Vocations Office
- Schedule physical exam—take form
- Schedule a psychological assessment with psychologist through the Vocations Office

## After all other steps are complete

- Schedule appointment with Bishop Brungardt through Yolanda Perez (620-227-1530)

## If accepted as a seminarian for the Diocese of Dodge City

- Complete seminary application and submit to Fr. John Stang ([vocationpromotion@dcdiocese.org](mailto:vocationpromotion@dcdiocese.org))
- Schedule seminary interview, if required

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
